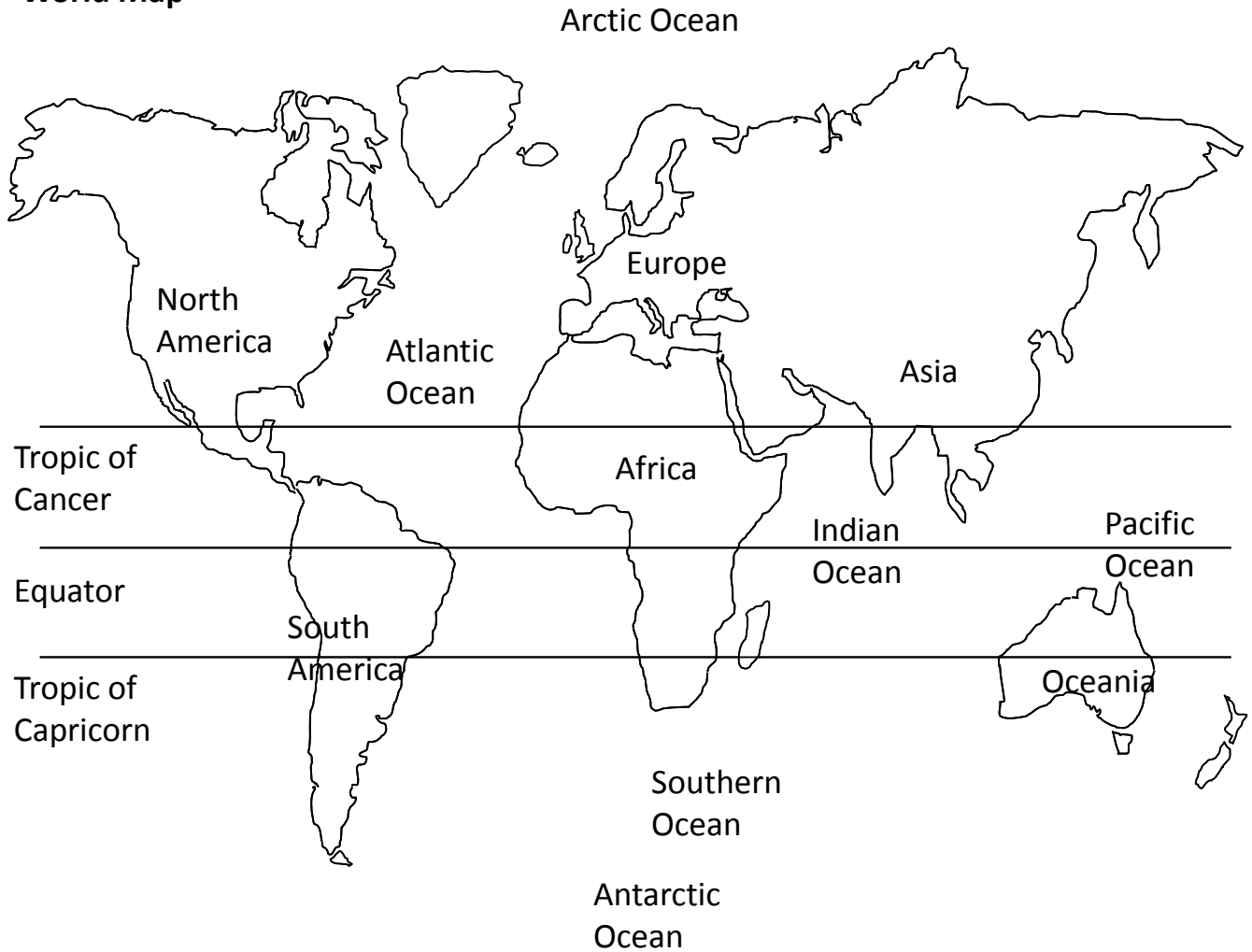


## World Map



In **physical geography** we need to describe the **relief**, **drainage** and **vegetation**.

To describe the relief on a map you need to use **contour lines** and **spot heights**. **Vegetation** is sometimes difficult to identify but is usually shown by symbols in the map's key.

**Human features** are 'man-made' items which include; **settlements** (houses) and **transport links** (roads, motorways etc.)
